

# Senior Privileges Document

From the Parent and Student Handbook - Senior Privileges

Each year, the senior class leadership determines criteria for senior privileges with the school administration. This may include but not be limited to being able to leave campus during unsupported study hall and lunch.

## Requirements

1. Seniors must have parent/guardian approval to be allowed privileges even if they are over 18.
2. A minimum of 17 credits will make you eligible for privileges.
3. A grade of C- or better on the previous report card/progress report.

## Expectations

1. In every respect, Senior Privileges shall be considered a responsibility. Any student who proves himself/herself incapable of assuming this responsibility may lose his/her privileges, and parents/guardians will be notified.
2. Seniors must be in good behavioral standing (no major infractions resulting in detention, in-school suspension or out of school suspension).
3. Seniors must be in good standing with attendance (fewer than 5 absences per semester in any one class)
4. Students must have their card present and show it each time you sign out early, sign in for late arrival or during callback.
5. Once seniors have signed out they must leave school grounds.
6. Please be aware that students are expected to be in their classes on time; if students are not, it will result in a loss of privileges.
7. Seniors who take underclassmen off campus during lunch will lose privileges.
8. Seniors may leave campus - walking, driving or riding with others. Oxbow will not monitor Seniors from the time they sign out until they sign back in. It is up to parents to set rules regarding out of school activities during Senior privileges.

Administration reserves the right to revoke Senior Privileges if it is determined to be in the student's best interest.

## Privileges

1. Students may be excused from Call Back Tuesday - Friday **IF** they are not requested by a teacher to be there. Students must report to callback Monday to look at their schedule and it is the responsibility of the student to check their Call Back schedule on a daily basis to avoid an unexcused absence.
2. Students may leave campus for unscheduled periods and lunch but they must sign out and back in with the front office.
3. Seniors with no assigned classes at the beginning of the day may sign in before their first scheduled class. The tardy policy will apply to seniors signing in later than their scheduled time.
4. Seniors with no assigned classes at the end of the day are allowed to leave early, but must sign out.
5. Other privileges must be negotiated before September 14th, 2018.
