In 2007, the Vermont Superintendents Association established the *Dr. Alice Angney Scholarship for Leadership and Service*. The scholarship is intended to recognize one Vermont high school senior with a financial award of \$2,000 dollars.

About Dr. Alice Angney

Dr. Alice Angney has served public education and the children of Vermont as an educator for more than 40 years. In 2007, after 21 years of service as a superintendent for the Lamoille South Supervisory Union, Dr. Angney retired. Dr. Angney's career can be characterized by devotion to children, dedication to public education, and a demonstrated commitment to excellence. She is a true leader and public servant.

About the Dr. Alice Angney Scholarship

In 2019 the Vermont Superintendents Association will award one \$2,000 scholarship to a deserving high school senior who resides in Vermont. The recipient will be chosen by a VSA selection committee on the basis of the student's initiative in overcoming a specific challenge, leadership and service to community, and academic achievement. The recipient will demonstrate a commitment to furthering his or her education after high school.

The selection committee will meet during the month of April to review applications. The scholarship recipient will be notified during the first week of May regarding his/her selection for the award. The scholarship will be paid upon confirmation of the student's enrollment in a post-secondary educational program.

To apply for the Dr. Alice Angney Scholarship, students must complete the accompanying application form and return it with the required materials to the Vermont Superintendents Association. **All materials must be received in the VSA office no later than NOON, Monday, March 18, 2019.**
